IWLCA Names Division III Honor and Merit Squads
Eleven NCAA participants earn honor status as a team

The IWLCA has honored 35 teams who have achieved high academic standing with their designation as honor squads, including three schools which have earned Merit Squad honors for a high team GPA for the 2006-2007 academic year. NCAA quarterfinalist Amherst College led all teams with a team GPA of 3.45, while MIT and Haverford College also earned Merit Squad honors. In addition, 33 teams were named Honor Squads after achieving a team GPA higher than 3.0. Included in this group are NCAA Champion TCNJ, NCAA semifinalist Middlebury, and eight other schools that participated in the NCAA tournament.
